

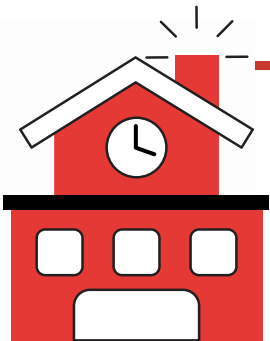
## Family Resource Centers

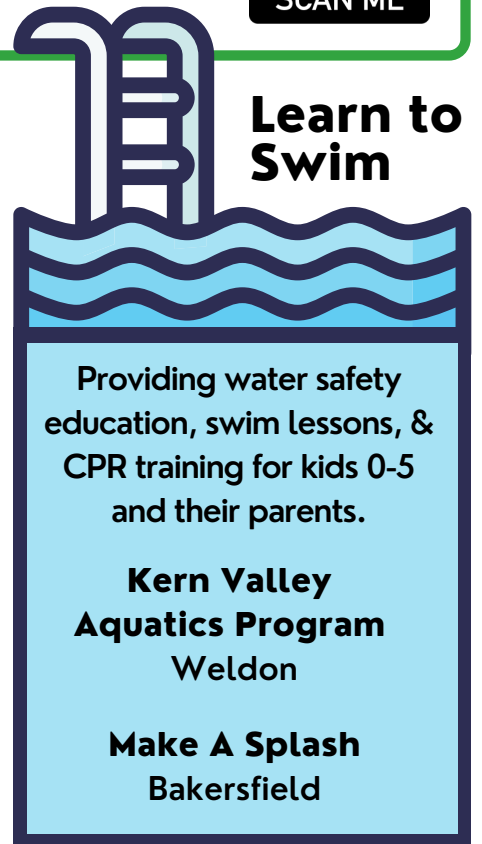


## Early Education Programs

A proactive program providing home visitations, integrated case management, and support services intended to reduce entry into child protective services.

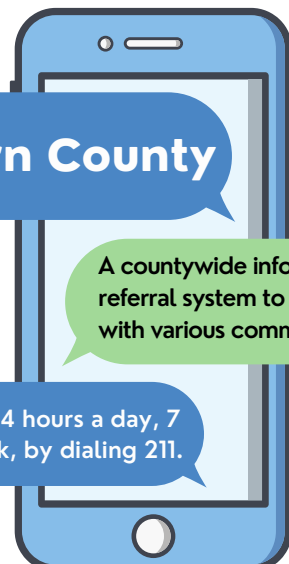
## Infant and Toddler Program
